

Auxiliary Services

Occasional Child Care Service

Provide occasional child care assistance for parents or carers with sudden engagements or various commitments.

Operation Hours

Same as the whole-day Nursery School service
(school will close on school holidays and Professional Development Days, details please refer to the website or enquire the school)

Fee (stipulated by the Social Welfare Department)

\$16 for a two-hour session (max. 4 sessions/ day) and \$6.5 for meal charge

Application Procedure

1. Contact school staff during service hours for advance reservation or register in-person
2. Parents/ guardian will need to bring along identity card (both original and copy), and the children's birth certificate (both original and copy)
3. Immediate acceptance of application will be considered if there is a vacancy

Extended Hours Service

Provide longer hours of child care assistance to meet the social needs of families and working parents.

Operation Hours

Same as the whole-day Nursery School service
Mon – Fri : After 6:00 pm Sat : After 1:00 pm
(school will close on school holidays and Professional Development Days, details please refer to the school calendar)

Fee (stipulated by the Social Welfare Department)

\$13/ hour

Application Procedure

1. Contact school staff during service hours for advance reservation or register in-person
2. For new service users, parents/ guardian will need to bring along identity card (both original and copy), and the children's birth certificate (both original and copy)
3. Complete application form
4. If application is accepted, consented documents are to be signed and payments are to be made immediately

Integrated Programme

- Children with special education needs are referred to school by the Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services of the Social Welfare Department.
- Teachers trained under the Integrated Programme will design individualized educational plan for each referred student after consulting the therapists. Training and care will also be provided to help SEN students better adapt to the society and mainstream education in the future. (This programme shares the same duration, fees, registration and withdrawal procedure as the school)

Admission

School Fee

1. School fee is approved by the government and annual adjustment will be made in September. Please refer to the website or enquire with the school for the latest information on fee.
2. Our Schools are eligible to join the Kindergarten Education Scheme. Needy families who require financial assistance may apply to the Student Finance Office for fee remission under the Kindergarten and Child Care Centre Fee Remission Scheme.

Application

- Download Application Form from download area of www.hkspc.org or collect from school directly, then submit the completed application form with the required supporting documents to the school by post or in person.
- All applicants will be notified by school upon receipt of the application form.

Interview Arrangement

Based on the vacancy situation, the school will contact parents if an interview is offered for admission to the school. The purpose of the interview is to understand the development and living habits of the children, as well as the care provided by the family to the children.

Admission Criteria

1. Age between 2 – 6 years old
2. Parents support the philosophy and teaching method of the school
3. Interview performance and certification by doctor
4. Applicant with sibling(s) currently studying in the school will be given due priority consideration after consideration of interview performance and number of vacancy
5. Applicant from families in need will be given priority consideration after consideration of interview performance and vacancy
** (As the number of school places is limited, please understand that not all applicants fulfilling the priority consideration will be guaranteed a school place.)

Announcement of Admission Result

Parents will be informed of the admission results by post.

Registration and Admission Procedure

1. Provide health screening documents issued by a Registered General Practitioner.
2. Successful applicants: Parents should complete the registration procedures including to submit the original Registration Certificate issued by Education Bureau (except for N1 Class) of their child and the registration fee** to the school within the stipulated time allocated by the school. The registration fee will be refunded one month after the enrollment of student.
3. Parents should present the required admission document, read and sign consent on all official admission documents.
** (Should parents decide to withdraw from school after registration, the registration fee will not be refunded.)

Withdrawal

Parents should notify the school one month in advance and sign the withdrawal documents.
