Parent-Child Play Effectiveness

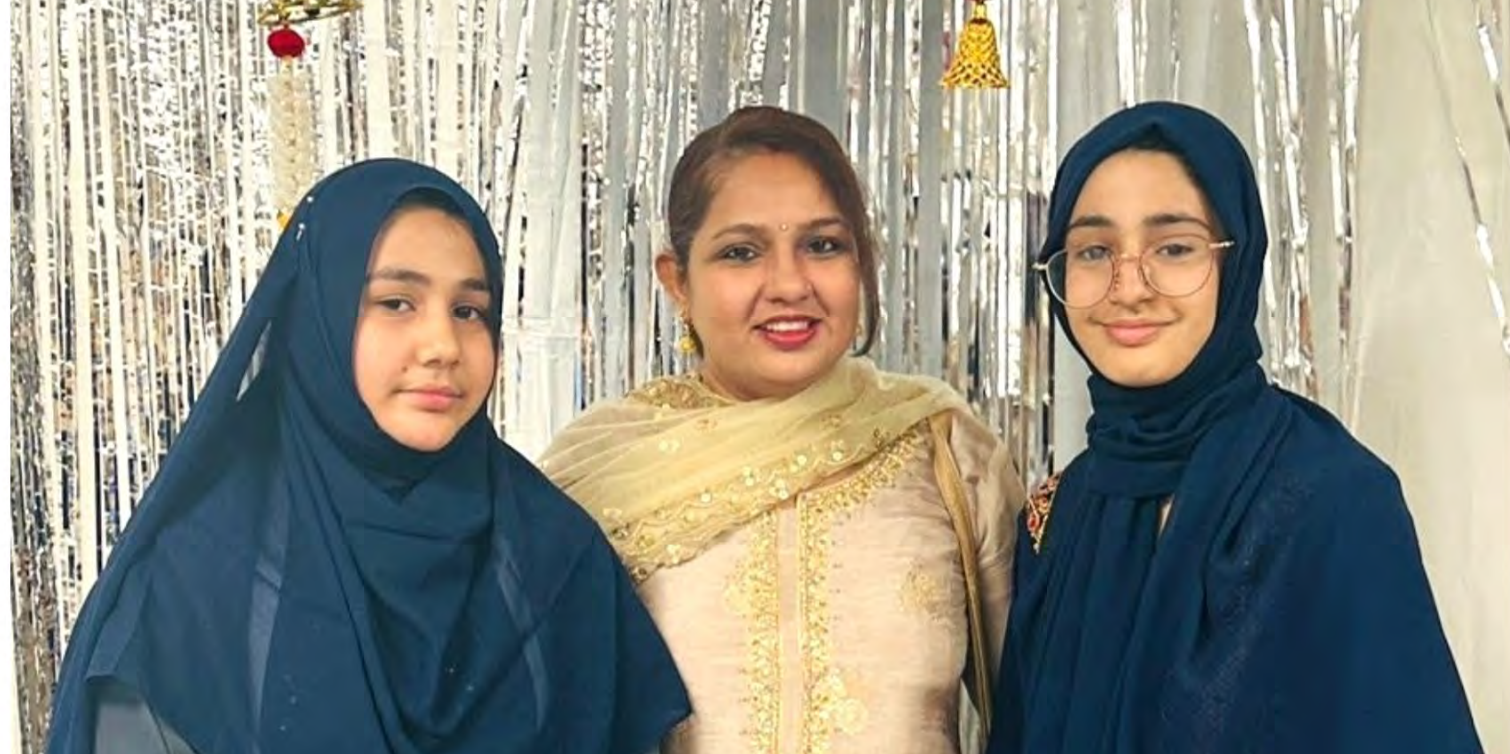
